

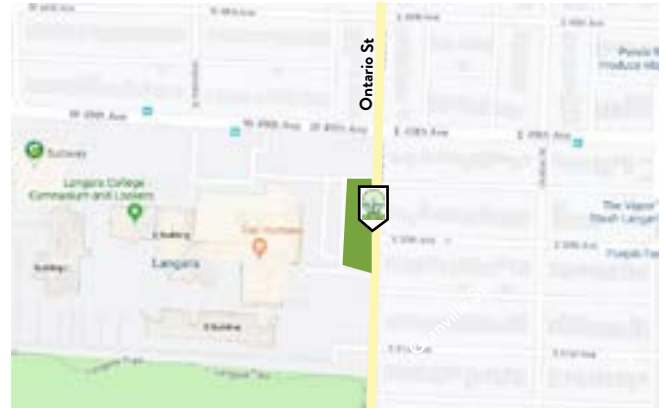


Getting to Langara College Community Day



THE BICYCLE VALET

The Bicycle Valet will be located in the green area on the west side of Ontario Street, between 49th and 50th Avenue.



BY BIKE



Ontario Street (Local Street Bikeway) runs from the Seawall to 71st Avenue and connects to Langara College. Going east-west, 59th Avenue (LSB) and 45th Avenue (LSB) both connect to Ontario St.

BY TRANSIT



The #015 runs directly south to Langara College from Cambie St. The #049 also runs directly to Langara east-west. Other busses that go southbound towards Langara include the #003, 008, 010, and 017. Taking the Canada Line, hop off at Langara-49th Station and we will be station on the north-eastern side of the campus.

All TransLink busses are equipped with front of bus bike racks and the SkyTrain permits two bikes per car outside of rush hour times. Remember, you can use TransLink and cycle with free bike parking at the entrance of the event, courtesy of The Bicycle Valet.
